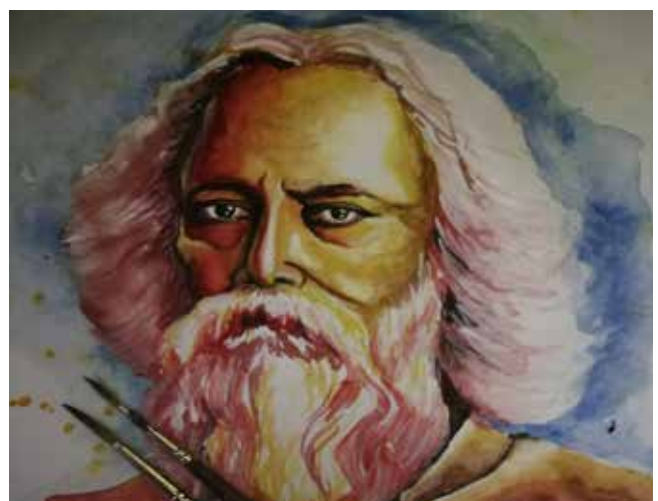

HYBRID CYCLE

I noticed an issue when it's an inclined road. It increases the human effort to travel from one destination to another, so sometimes we experience sore muscles and get very much exhausted. So i designed a recommendation, or let's say, a solution to address the problem.

1) We can induce a electric motor (special motor)



The above marked area shows where the motor will be induced

The materials required:

- 1) Special Motor (Electric Motor)
- 2) Push Button
- 3) Connecting Wires
- 4) Ball Bearings

The below image represents the Push button required for the mobility of the cycle.



The working mechanism of the cycle:

When the riders sense that there is an inclined road (slope) getting close, they use the switch (which is attached to the handlebar) to switch it "on and off".

Here, in this case, there will be a couple of connecting wires which will be connected to the motor. The ball bearings plated in the tires and the mobility of the cycle.

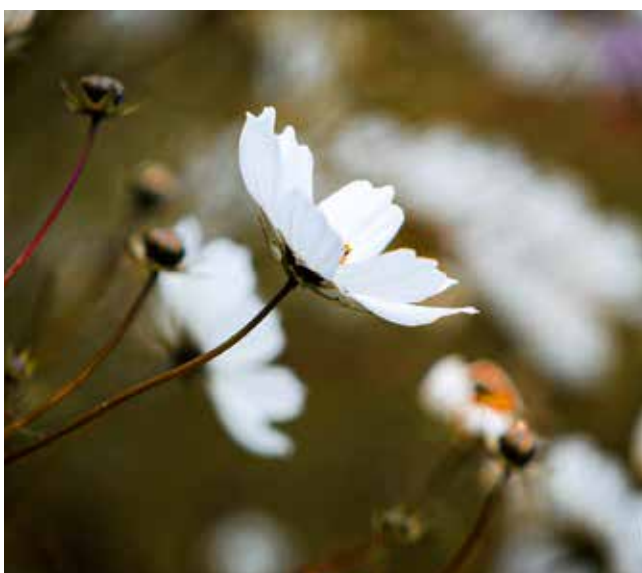
When the switch is on, there will be a current flow towards the motor, which is then passed on to the connecting wires to activate the mobility. And this will be helpful for the movement of the bike on inclined roads. The rider should switch off the button so that they can stop the automatic movement of the cycle. 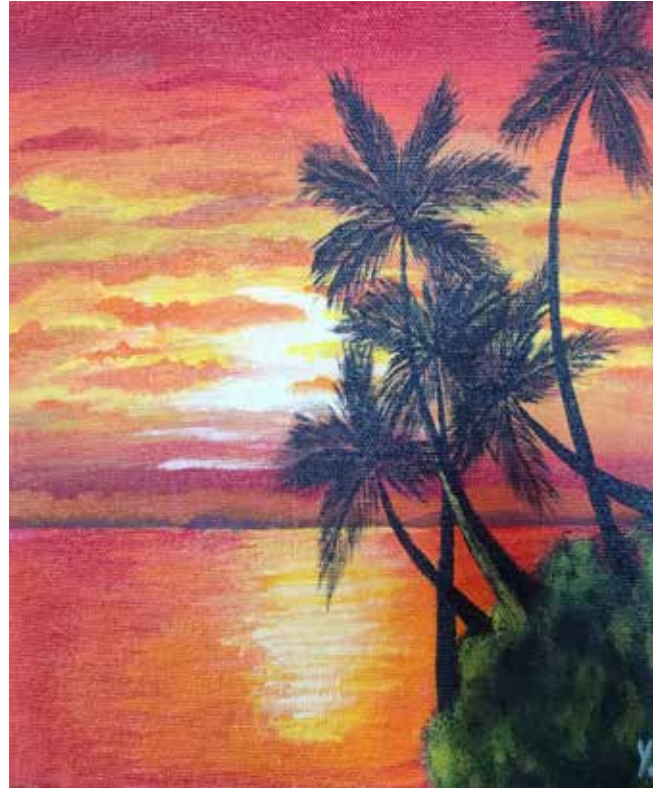

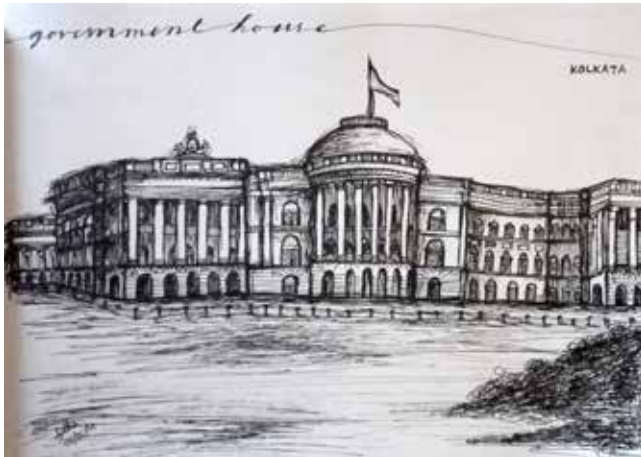

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The mind of man is nothing if not extraordinary. It has been of significant help in the coming about of today's world. From the exceptional inventions of the wheel by early man to artificial intelligence, minds have thought it all. There was an idea first, it was developed by utilizing various mediums, be it tools or designing of programmes as in the case of artificial intelligence, and the result was the creation of history!

Intellectual property (IP) refers to the creations of minds, be it inventions, literary and artistic works, designs, symbols, names or images used in commerce. IP law is a fairly new arena of law, when humans can register movable and immovable properties. Maybe it was thought, why to leave IP behind? At least with the former denying the right of a malicious claimant can be a cakewalk if the rightful owner can prove his ownership with the necessary documents, but when it comes to IP it becomes extremely important to confer uncompromising rights. Rights in the nature of laws are available to ensure there is no assertion by another than its creator as to the ownership of the creation. However, rights are not just to exclude others from using, selling or producing the protected asset but to provide the holder with the right to license the rights for commercial or other bonafide uses. The requirements for obtaining registration vary as per the type of IP that is needed to be registered.

Here's an attempt to explain the various intellectual properties briefly. Copyrights related to the expression of ideas; rights protect the expression of an idea rather than the idea itself. It includes literary, musical, dramatic, artistic, cinematography work, audio tapes and computer software. In the bizarre case of *Naruto v. Slater*, photographer David Slater, innocently left his camera unattended in an Indonesian reserve. What came next was a long-run legal dispute, begun by a crested macaque, "Naruto", snapping cheeky selfies with the camera. These images were published in a book, and subsequently, PETA, took legal action as his 'next friend' against Slater, for copyright infringement. It was however concluded that Naruto, an animal, lacked statutory standing in law to sue. Nonetheless, Slater agreed to donate 25% of all future proceeds from the use of the selfies to charities protecting crested macaques' habitats.

A trademark is a sign capable of distinguishing the goods or services of one enterprise from those of another which may include the shape of goods, their packaging, etc. Interestingly, trademarks date back to ancient times when artisans used to put their signature or "mark" on their works. A befitting example of a trademark could be of the company "Nike" which registered their trademark in the special format, the word "Nike" above a tick with their swoosh logo, "just do it". That's some branding I'd say, marketing must be a walk in the park! A walk in the park needs shoes right?

A patent provides the patent owner with the rights to decide how and

whether the invention of his can be used by others. In exchange for the right, the patent owner willingly makes technical information about the invention publicly available. Apparently, hundreds of patents for self-driving car technology exist and here I was just starting to learn to drive a car. The company, "VisLab" broke through the barrier of existing patents of self-driving car technology with its car, "BRAiVE" which navigated two-way streets, crosswalks, and other obstacles in Italy.

A geographical indication (GI) is a sign used on products that have a specific geographical origin and possess characteristics or a reputation that are due to that origin. It enables those who have the right to use the indication to prevent its use by a third party whose product does not conform to the applicable standards. Inspiringly, in the jurisdictions in which the Darjeeling geographical indication is protected, producers of Darjeeling tea can exclude the use of the term "Darjeeling" for tea not grown in their tea gardens or not produced according to the standards set out in the code of practice.

An industrial design constitutes the ornamental or aesthetic aspect of a thing. A design may consist of three or two - dimensions such as the shape of an article and patterns, lines or colors respectively. The Mini Cooper by designer Alec Issigonis, tasked with designing a car that was more economical than the large cars of the day, was aimed at competing with increasingly popular German bubble cars. The design became a true British icon and continues

to influence generations of car designers.

Trade secrets are intellectual property rights upon confidential information which may be sold or licensed. The unauthorized acquisition, use or disclosure in a manner contrary to honest commercial practices by others is regarded as an unfair practice and a violation of the trade secret protection. Coca-Cola's secret formula which has been locked up in a vault is an example that has stayed protected without revelation.

Intellectual property rights give businesses a competitive advantage, prevent unauthorized use of intellectual property and works, facilitate collaborations for generating income by entering into licensing agreements and create brand value. Each industry should evolve its own intellectual property policies, management style, strategies, etc. and reconcile these with the existing national laws and international treaties and practices.

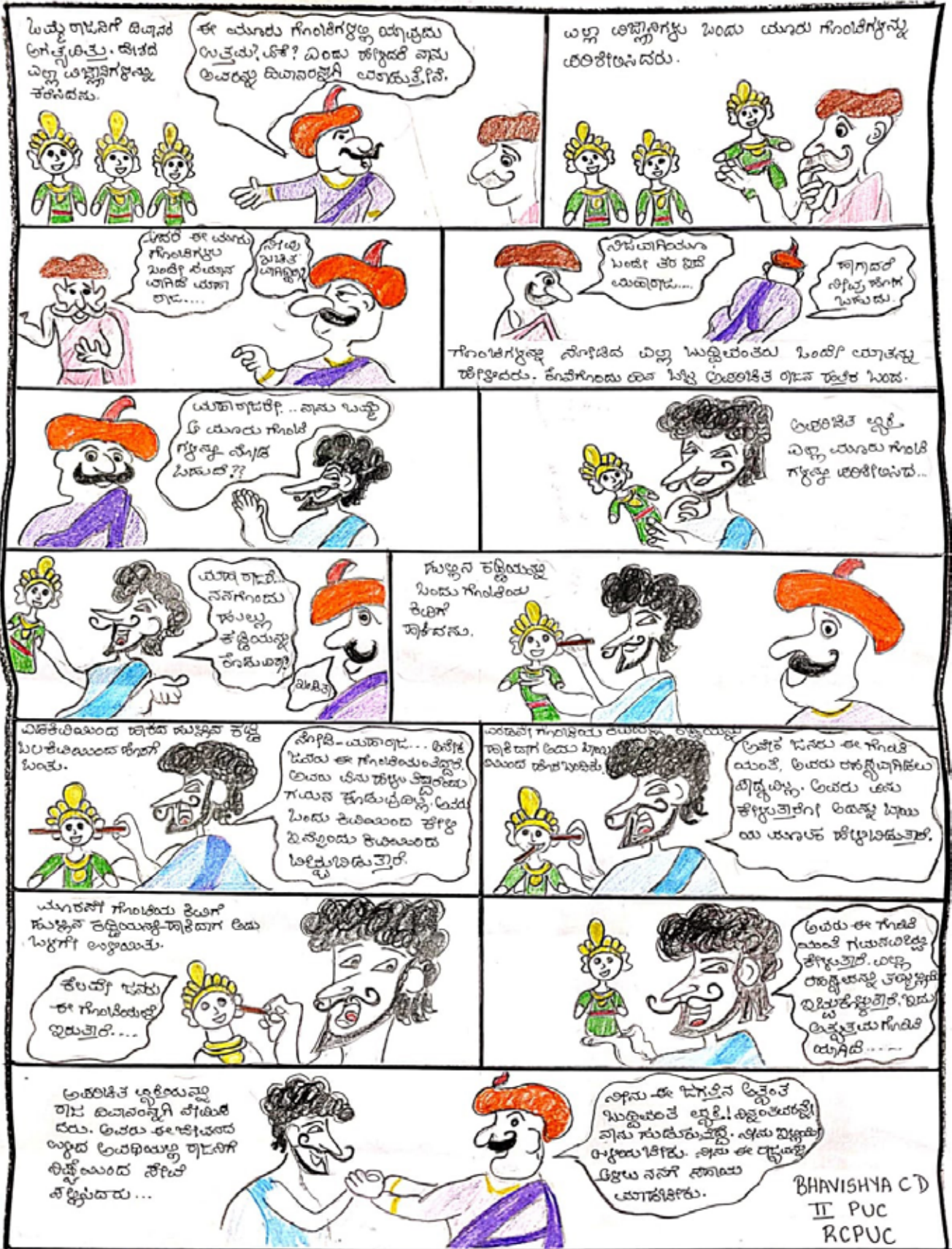

In which lives a soul who thinks like me, maybe little less or more.

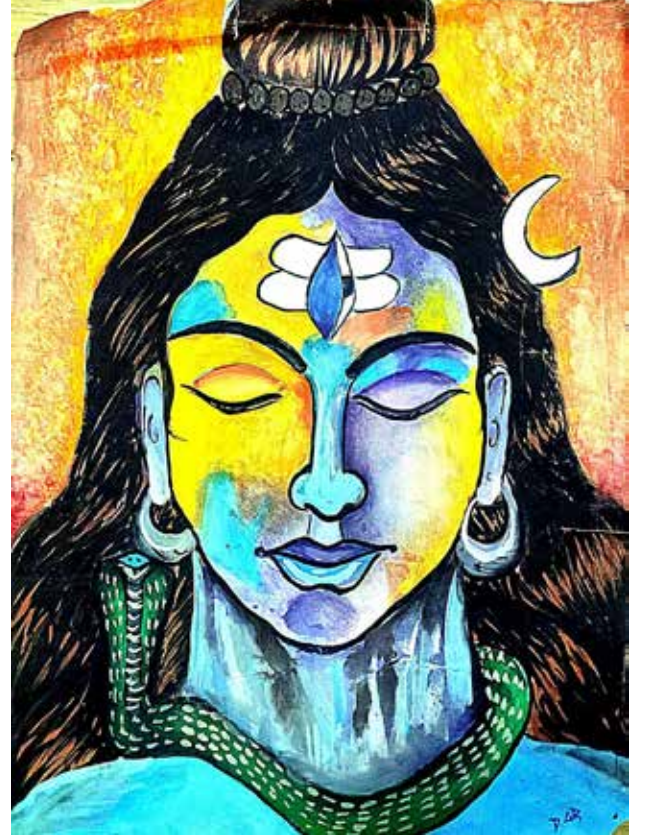

ALGORITHM TRADING - AN INSIGHT

Algorithm trading is a type of trading which uses algorithms to make automated, high-speed trading decisions. The main objective of Algorithm trading is to take advantage of market volatility and exploit small price movements. This type of trading has become increasingly popular over the last few years, and now constitutes a large portion of the trading volume in financial markets. This is mainly because of the presence of Supplementary Liquidity Providers (SLPs) who have indulged themselves in algo trading.

Algorithm refers to the set of commands which the computer follows for executing a particular task.

Using algorithm in trading is called Algo trading.

In algorithmic trading, a trader writes a set of rules that define when to enter and exit trades.

Algorithm trading is nothing but automating your trades using a strategy based on an algorithm with several constraints.

Another benefit of algorithm trading is its ability to manage risk. By using algorithms to make trades, traders can automate the limit the amount of risk they are willing to take on in a given trade. For example, a trader can easily set a maximum loss limit, so if the trade goes against them, the algorithm will automatically square

off the trade, thereby limiting the losses.

Algorithm trading allows you to instantly place your order without any human involvement. It also mitigates the possible manual errors caused while placing orders.

Since the orders are completely automated, algorithmic trading can help you avoid making emotional decisions thereby avoiding loss aversion.

This type of trading has become increasingly popular in recent years due to its ability to execute trades faster and with more accuracy than a human trader could.

Some platforms which provide algorithmic trading are Streak, Tradetron etc..

Popular strategies in algorithm trading are:-

1. High frequency trading (HFT)
– It is a type of trading where huge number of orders are continuously placed in order to capture minute changes in prices.
2. Arbitrage - Traders tend to program the computer to find arbitrage opportunities. Whenever the system detects a significant difference in the prices of the same stock in different markets, it immediately places the orders.

Computers can analyse vast amounts of market data in real-time and make trades in a matter of milliseconds.

As much as there are benefits of using algorithm trading, it is not devoid of drawbacks. Some of which are-

- Technical glitches are unavoidable, sometimes orders might get placed at unwanted prices.
- Not suitable for individuals with low capital.
- Back testing reports are manipulated to attract potential clients.
- Lots of restrictions from regulatory bodies.

In conclusion, Algorithmic trading is a helpful tool for traders. However, one must have proper understanding of the risks associated in also trading. By using effectively, algorithmic trading can be a valuable tool for traders who want to succeed in the markets by maximizing their profits while limiting their losses.

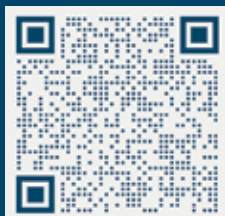
