PRINCIPALS MEETING



The Principals meeting was convened at Government PU College Malleshwaram on 10th December 2024 which was attended by our principal, Flt Lt Sunita Dixit. The agenda primarily focused on the arrangements for the upcoming Third Test, alongside addressing various operational protocols and logistics. Key points discussed are as follows:

Custodian Arrangements: The custodian for the examination process is set to be the same. The custodian is required to be present to open the question paper at 9:30 AM. It is imperative that any tampering incidents be reported to the principal of the nodal center without delay. The custodian must meticulously record the number of question papers accessed. Custodians are also required to observe the distribution of the question papers and can alert the principal if any issues arise.

Preparatory Exams: Preparatory examinations will take place from January 17 to January 28.

Diary Release: The release of the academic diary is set for January. A soft copy of the diary will be available for review, encompassing Forms 1-14 and the status of applications across various student categories.

Faculty Enrollment and Evaluation: All faculty members are to be enrolled for assessments. Updates on SATs from the first midterm exams will be maintained.

Webcasting and Data Management: There will be webcasting provisions for both practical and theory examinations. Essential details such as the name of the college, the teacher, the principal, and contact information (phone number and email) will need to be documented. It is critical that CCTV surveillance is operational, with continuous recording and backup ensured. An uninterrupted power supply is mandatory.

User Access Control: Users must log in with the credentials provided by the PU Board, and UPS systems will be connected to computers handling exam footage.

Competitions and Cultural Events: The cultural events will be conducted at Ramnagar BGS institution on 11th of December 2024. Transportation for cultural events will be managed by BGS.

Competitive exams: JEE, NEET and Kcet exams should be given to all the teachers. Government colleges will get the links to solve the competitive questions online.
