



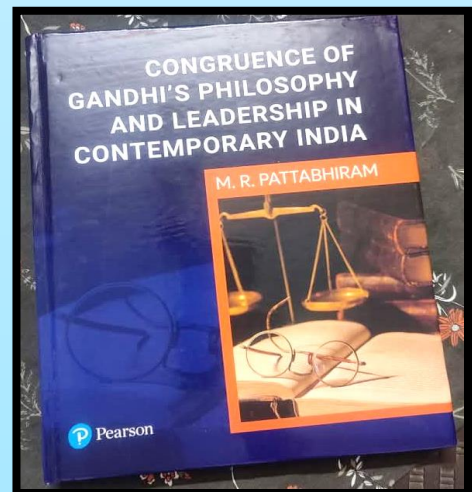

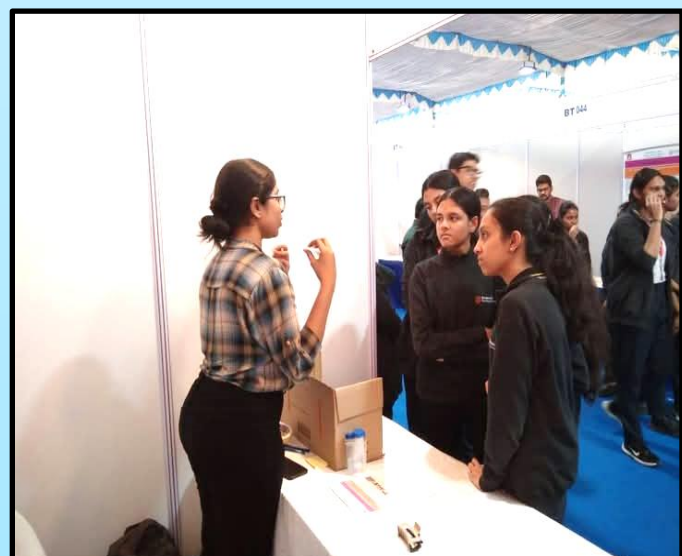


PRADARSHANA -2025
