INTER-CLASS FOOTBALL



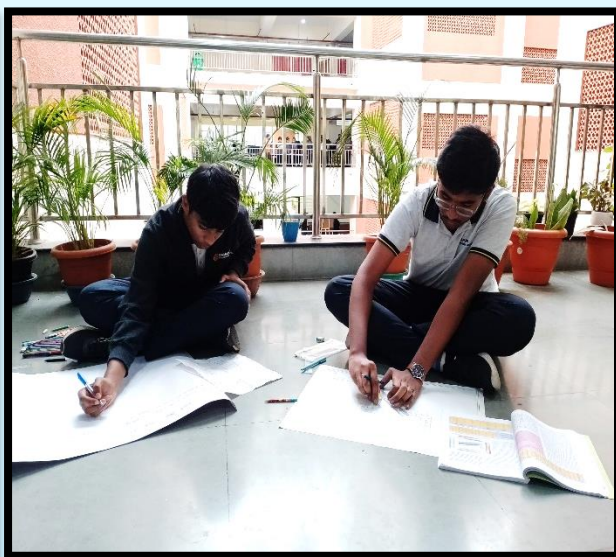
