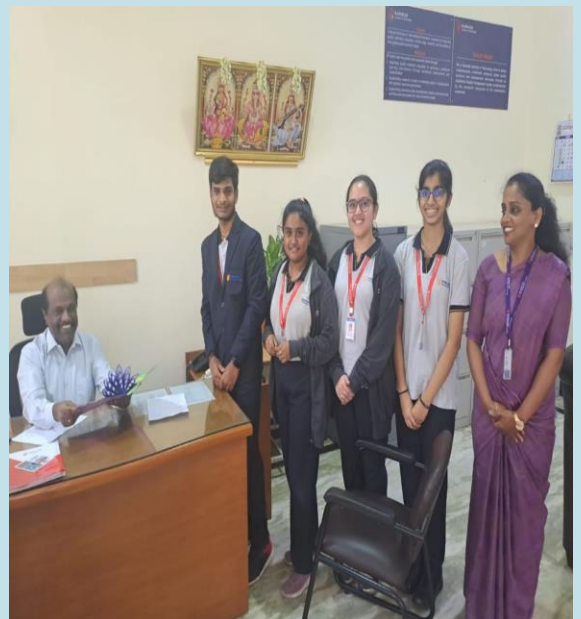

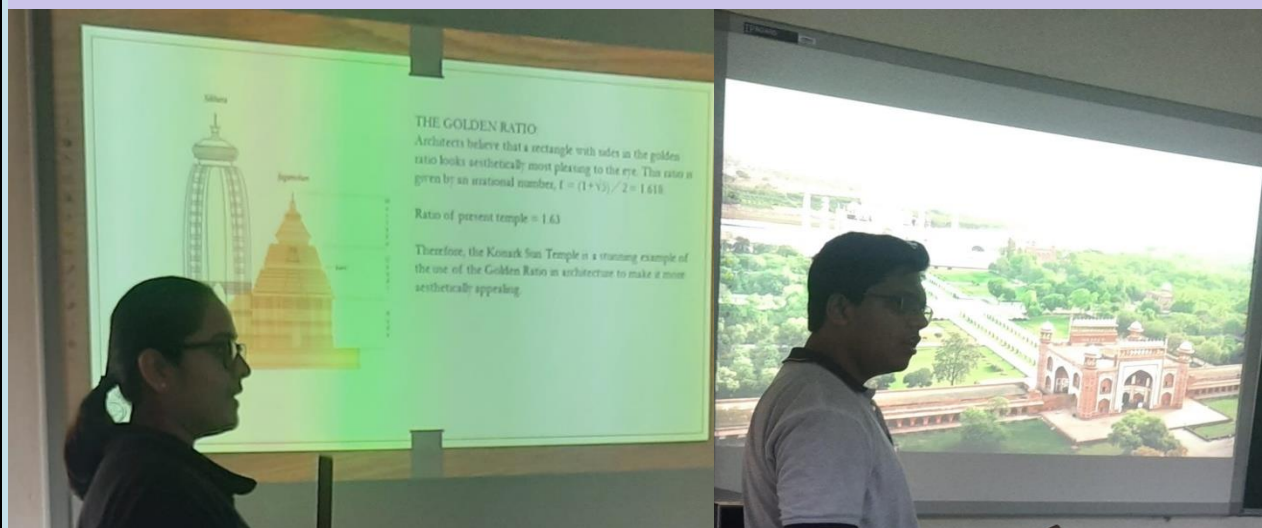
GET CREATIVE WITH POSTERS!
